Guidelines and Procedures:

General information:

- We will follow all guidelines and procedures recommended by the CDC, the State of Georgia, the Chattahoochee Council, and all municipalities within our council.
- All units will be expected to follow the procedures and guidelines outlined to ensure a safe and successful experience for all involved.
- **Mask and social distancing will be required in camp to protect from COVID-19.**
- **Please be respectful of ALL volunteers & follow their directions.**
- **Make sure ALL parents and leaders know not to park in front of, besides, or enter District Executive's home.**

Changes to Camp:

- There will be a maximum of 350 participants allowed to attend each weekend.
- **There will be NO onsite registration.**
- Each pack will have a round robin schedule to limit the number of participants in each area; please follow your schedule.
- Group gatherings such as opening, closing and campfires will have areas to social distance.

Check in Procedures:

- All participants will have health screen/temperature check upon arrival.
 - If anyone in a vehicle has a temperature of 100.4 or greater, everyone in that vehicle will not be allowed in camp.
 - Everyone will receive a wristband once temperature has been checked and check in has been completed before leaving your vehicle.
 - Wristbands **MUST ALWAYS BE WORN!**
 - If you are in camp without a wristband you will be directed to the onsite Camp Chairman.
 - Vehicles will not be allowed in campsites after sunset on Friday until Camp ends on Sunday. We will have ways to help get gear to campsites safely. **PLEASE HELP US INSURE EVERYONE KNOWS THIS.**
 - T-shirts will be distributed to **Leaders Only** during leaders meeting Saturday morning (time and location will be announced on REMIND) then leaders will pass them out at campsites.
 - Masks will be given to leaders along with fabric markers so that Scouts may decorate them in camp before starting rotations. Please make sure they include their name and pack number when decorating.

Communication:

- Communication will be handled with the REMIND APP (this is a free download in the App store for Apple & Android). Please have your families subscribe to the weekend they will be attending. This will be where updates and changes will be posted.
- If there is a question or problem that arises, please request assistance on REMIND as well.
- Updates and Lost and Found will also be posted at the Bath house.

To join if you do not have app, simply send a new text message to **81010** with the corresponding code for the week attending.

If you already have the app, go to Join class and enter the code for your weekend and click join.

Camp Procedures:

- Promote good hygiene, wash, and sanitize hands regularly (there will be sanitizing and wash stations throughout camp as well as at all activity stations and bath house).
- No sharing of personal equipment such as water bottles (PLEASE make sure everyone brings their own).
- Mask will be worn at all times, except when eating.
- All surfaces and stations will be disinfected after each use.
- Social distancing will be practiced as much as possible.

First Aid:

- Each Pack should have a First Aid kit in campsites. There will also be first aid at rotations.
- Should an emergency arise that requires more, please immediately alert your Cubmaster and use best judgement if 911 is needed then alert camp chairman via REMIND.

Sleeping Arrangements:

- Please Space tents out.
- Only Families may share tents.

Cooking in Camp suggestions:

- Disinfect all surfaces & wash hands before, during & after cooking.
- Limit number of cooks.
- No self-serve lines.
- Servers need to have mask and gloves.
- No utensil sharing.
