Overview of Spring Family Camp:

Activities- Slime Fun, Obstacle Course, Hamster Run, Tie Dye, Flag Dig, Water Balloon Pop.

General information:

- We will follow all guidelines and procedures recommended by the CDC, The State of Georgia, The Chattahoochee Council, and all municipalities within our council.
- All units will be expected to follow the procedures and guidelines outlined to ensure a safe and successful experience for all involved.
- Mask and social distancing will be required in camp to protect from Covid 19
- Please be respectful of ALL volunteers & follow their directions.
- Make sure ALL parents and leaders know not to park in front of, next to, or enter District Executives home
- All times are EST. Please make sure your phone is set to stay on EST or it may automatically switch to CST.

Changes to Camp:

- There will be NO onsite registration
- Each pack will have a round robin schedule to limit the number of participants in each area, please follow your schedule.
- Group gatherings such as opening, closing and campfires will have areas to social distance.

Check in Procedures:

- All participants will have health screen/temperature check upon arrival
 - If anyone in a vehicle has a temp of 100.4 or greater everyone in that vehicle will not be allowed in camp.
 - NO check in or dropping off vehicles/equipment before 4:00pm EST on Friday.
 - Vehicles will not be allowed in campsites after sunset on Friday. We will have ways to help get gear to campsites safely. PLEASE SHARE THIS IMPORTANT INFORMATION WITH YOUR PARENTS.
 - o ALL vehicles must be out of campsites before sunset on Friday night.
 - o Saturday morning check in is from 7am-9am.
 - Everyone will receive a wristband once temp has been checked and check in has been completed before leaving your vehicle.
 - Wristbands MUST be worn at ALL TIMES!

- If you are in camp without a wristband you will be directed to onsite Camp Director
- Shirts will be distributed to Leaders when they check in.

Camp Volunteers:

As you know it takes a great number of volunteers to run camp & that number has increased due to Covid. Please consider helping in a station, or with check in, Parking, setup or take down.

Communication:

- Communication will be handled with the REMIND APP (this is a free download in the app store for Apple & Android), Please have your families subscribe. This will be where updates and changes will be posted and make it easier for pack leadership to share important information.
- If there is a question or problem that arises please request assistance on REMIND as well
- Updates and Lost and Found will also be posted at the Bath house

To join if you don't have app:

Open to send a new text message, in the "To" box type **81010** in the message box type code **@hk2f9g2** and in the press send.

If you already have the app, go to join class and enter the code and click join

Camp Procedures:

- Promote good hygiene, wash and sanitize hands regularly. There will be sanitizing and wash stations throughout camp as well as at all stations and bath house.
- No sharing of personal equipment such as water bottles.

- Mask must be worn if a 6ft distance cannot be maintained.
- All surfaces and stations will be disinfected after each use.
- Social distancing will be practiced as much as possible.

Attire:

There will be water sports and messy fun, please be prepared with extra clothes for scouts to get dirty. Swimsuits may be worn under clothes. No open toed shoes are allowed. Must follow BSA guidelines.

Sunscreen is recommended.

First Aid:

- Each Pack should have a first Aid kit and health forms parts A & B in campsites. There will also be first aid kits at rotations.
- Should an emergency arise that requires professional attention Call 911 and alert the nearest staff member to contact the Camp Director.

Sleeping Arrangements:

Only those in the same household may share tents.

Cooking in Camp:

- Disinfect all surfaces & wash hands before, during & after cooking
- Limit number of cooks
- No Self-serve lines
- Servers need to have mask & gloves
- No utensil sharing

If someone shows signs or Symptoms of a communicable disease:

- A leader must contact the Onsite Director immediately.
- The individual will be isolated until they can leave camp property. (As soon as possible)
- Others that have been in contact will be notified immediately
