### Arrow of Light Participation

Arrow of Light (AOL) Scouts are invited to join Scouts BSA units for this event. AOLs can camp overnight Friday and/or Saturday night with a Scouts BSA unit. Please use this event to visit several units to learn more about each unit and the fun that awaits you on the Scouts BSA level. AOLs will be able to participate in most events, a few may be restricted due to the Guide to Safe Scouting Guidelines, those will be clarified at the leader meeting on Friday night (or upon check-in)

### Cancellation/Refund Policy

No refunds for participants who cancel after registration closes on 1/26/2021 or do not show up for the event. If any governmental agencies force the cancellation of this event, refunds will be available.

### Campsite Selection

Campsites will not be assigned for this event. Sites are available on a first come first serve basis. Camp will open at 4pm officially for unit check in and site selection. We will have some signage located throughout camp for sites that are not necessarily labeled as sites but are often used to help those who are new to this event. Please practice Leave No Trace and Tread Lightly principals for locations that are not established sites. Units will be expected to help clean camp prior to checking out on Sunday January 31<sup>st</sup>.

### COVID Guidelines

Units are asked to perform the standard COVID screening prior to arrival. Please complete the checklist for each participant and submit with signed Hold Harmless Agreement at check in for each person entering camp. If you are sick or feel unwell, STAY HOME.

**Please note units will need to follow their own COVID precautions and guidelines while at camp.**

## Check-In

Troops may arrive any time after 4pm. Check-in will occur at Turtle Rock at Camp Gallant. Please leave your unit in the vehicles and bring all documentation to the check-in station. Any necessary materials will be shared for units to distribute to your Scouts once at the campsite.

### Bring to Check-in:

- Roster of Scouts attending with your unit
- Contact name and phone number for Leader(s) in charge in case of emergency.
- Signed Chattahoochee Council COVID-19 Release form for every participant.
- Remember this is a BSA event so you are required to have Health forms (Parts A&B) for every member of your troop that is on site; we will not be collecting these but A Scout is Trustworthy so we trust you will have these.

Each Unit registered for the event is expected to help run an activity or skills event. Activities should be set up around the main loop. Event staff will coordinate location by Friday Leader Meeting.
